HISTORY OF THE ROSARY

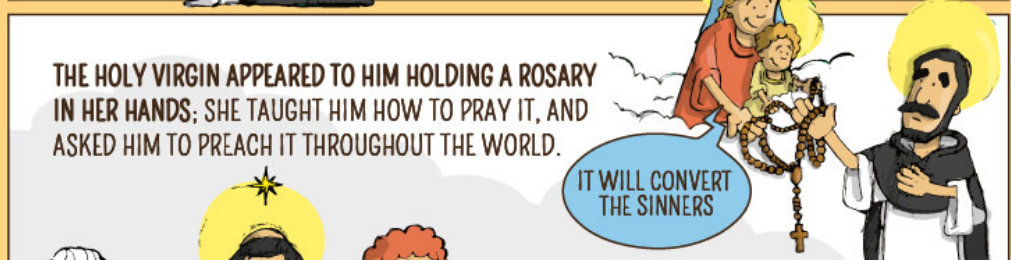

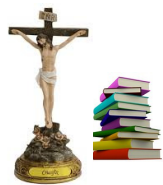


Pastoral Letter on the Evangelization and Catechesis in the Family

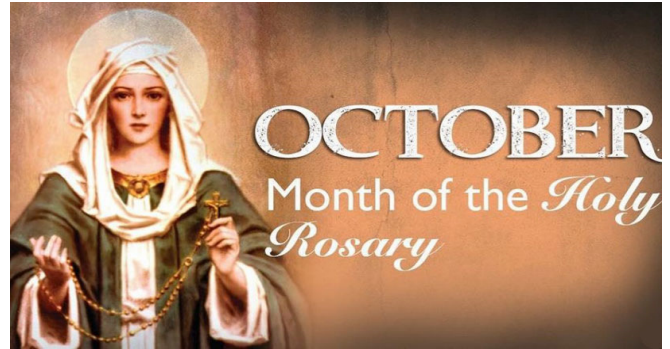
